ABEL, Ernst Heinrich

?Köthen 20.IX.1725 – p.1783

Considerable uncertainty surrounds the portraitist Ernst Heinrich Abel. Ernst August Abel (*q.v.*) is recorded as having two brothers both with these names, each born in Köthen, one on 20.IX.1721, who presumably died in infancy, the other on 20.IX.1725. But a nephew, also called Ernst Heinrich Abel, of Hamburg is mentioned in the administration of the estate of the composer Karl Friedrich Abel who died in London in 1787. He is possibly the pastellist. Ernst Heinrich is known from a miniature of Queen Charlotte signed E. H. Abel/1763, presumably executed while he was in London; he was then recorded in Köln (1779), Hamburg and Bremen (1783). He worked in various media, including oil painting.
