ARNULPHY, Pierre

Aix-en-Provence 22.X.1732–9.IV.1765

The elder son of the painter Claude Arnulphy (*q.n.*) was buried in the Madeline, Aix-en-Provence on 10.IV.1765 aged 32, described as a “peintre” like his father. He had been baptised in the same church, his godparents being Pierre Arnulphy and Jeanne Jourdan. One work survives, evidently by this otherwise forgotten artist.
