The unrecorded gouachiste signs illegibly, the first initial being completely unreadable (perhaps L., but it seems unlikely to be Louis-François Aubry, *q.v.*), as is the date. The work is a copy of the coloured print by Charles-Melchior Descourtis (1753–1820) after Taunay.
