AUDRAN, Jean

Lyon 28.IV.1667 – Paris 17.VI.1756

Member of the extended family of engravers; pupil of his uncle Girard. He was appointed graveur du roi in 1707 with an apartment at the Gobelins. Among his portrait engravings was one after a pastel by Vivien. He is likely to be the “M. Audran, Directeur de la Manufacture royale des Gobelins” credited with a pastel in a 1761 sale; according to an annotation on the catalogue, “ce tableau est en tapisserie de petit point seret”.
