## **BAILLIE, William**

England 1743 – Calcutta 1799

Painter, draughtsman and engraver. He went to India in 1777 to serve in the Bengal Infantry, but transferred to the Engineers and became a surveyor. Ten years later he resigned his commission but remained active as a topographical artist. According to his letter to Humphry, he intended to take up pastels with Russell's treatise as guide. It is not known if he did so.
