BAUZIL, Jean-Guillaume-Jacques

Köln 1766 – Madrid 1820

Also Bauziel, Bausil (or Bausit in the 1786 livret); Juan Guillermo Santiago (or Jacobo) Bauzil in some Spanish sources. He was the son of Jean Bausil and Anne-Marie Kochs. Portraitist; pupil of Labeyrie at the Académie de Toulouse 1784–89 (too early for Bénézit's date of birth, 1776). From 1787 he advertised as a miniaturist and a number of works in this medium are known. He was in Paris in 1793 where he married Marie-Jeanne-Charlotte Gentillon on 10.X.1793 (a son, Jacques-Charles, died en nourrice in the Val d'Oise, 1.III.1794) before being appointed pintor de cámara to Carlos IV in Madrid in 1797. Some of his royal portraits were engraved by Rafael Estève in 1802.
