## **BAUZIL, Juan**

Köln 1766 – Madrid 1820

Also Bauziel (or Bausit in the 1786 livret). Portraitist; pupil of Labeyrie at the Académie de Toulouse 1784–89 (too early for Bénézit's date of birth, 1776). From 1787 he advertised as a miniaturist and a number of works in this medium are known. He was in Paris in 1793 before being appointed pintor de cámara to Carlos IV in Madrid in 1797.
