BEAUBRUN, Charles

Amboise 1604 – Paris 1692

The cousins Charles and Henri Beaubrun, members of an extended dynasty of painters, excelled at the crayon drawings fashionable in the royal court of the time; according to Guillet de Saint-Georges, Henri was chosen by the king to give him lessons in the art of pastel. Although their paintings are difficult to distinguish, Henri alone seems to have worked in miniature.
