BLANCHET, Louis-Gabriel

Versailles 1701 – Rome 17.IX.1772

Won second prix de Rome in 1727 and stayed in Rome thereafter, working principally as a portraitist in oils. He was supported by Vleughels and the duc de Saint-Aignan. No pastels are known by him, but some of his portraits were copied by others. Among his pupils was Katherine Read (*q.v.*).
