CHAMPAIGNE, Jean-Baptiste de

Bruxelles 10.XII.1631 – Paris 27.X.1681

Nephew and pupil of Philippe de Champaigne (*q.n.*); there are some drawings with trois crayons or coloured chalk, including two sheets in the Louvre attributed to him. His work is also confused with that of Nicolas de Plattemontagne (*q.n.*), a fellow pupil of his uncle.
