COCLERS, dit van WYCK, Philippe-Henri

Liège 1738 – Marseille 1803/4

Miniaturist; son of Jean-Baptiste-Pierre Coclers. Known as van Wyck or Wick, he was a pupil of Pêcheux in Rome, where he drew the Aix pastel in 1772. He moved to Marseille in 1776 where he became rector and then directeur of the Académie royale.
