DEL ROSSO, Sig.ra Zanobi, née Francesca Stradetti

fl. Rome 1757–67

“Consorte dell’architetto” according to the livret of the exhibition where she sent two pastels “sua proprietà”. She was recorded as residing in Rome when she was elected to the Accademia in Florence in 1758. She is described as a “pittrice pratese” in one report in 1832. Her husband was a pupil of Clocchi in Florence and Vanvitelli in Rome before being appointed architetto delle fabbriche reali to Granduca Pietro Leopoldo. Their son, cavaliere Giuseppe (1760–1831), was an even more important architect, while his brother Filippo (1761–1823) was a scholar.
