DEL ROSSO, Sig.ra Zanobi, née Francesca Stradetti

fl. Florence 1767

“Consorte dell’architetto” according to the livret of the exhibition where she sent two pastels “sua proprietà”. She is described as a “pittrice pratese” in one report in 1832. Her husband was a pupil of Ciochi in Florence and Vanvitelli in Rome before being appointed architetto delle fabbriche reali to Granduca Pietro Leopoldo. Their son, cavaliere Giuseppe (1760–1831), was an even more important architect, while his brother Filippo (1761–1823) was a scholar.
