DELATOUR, Mme Philippe-François, née Marie-Élisabeth-

Jeanne Simons

Bruxelles 1750–1834

The miniaturist, interior painter and engraver Élisabeth Simons was the sister-in-law of the little-known Flemish painter Charles Leclercq and mother of Alexandre Delatour, a pupil of Augustin and Autissier. Her brother Jean-Baptiste Simons had been a prize-winner at the Bruxelles académie in 1772; when he went blind in 1786 she gave him some of her pictures, which included some pastels.
