DENNER, Balthazar

Hamburg 15.XI.1685 – Rostock 14.IV.1749

A painter, draughtsman, etcher and miniaturist who produced religious, genre and still life pictures and portraits. He was trained in Gdańsk and (from 1707) Berlin (Akademie der Künste). He worked for Fredrik IV in Denmark in 1717. Later he travelled between London (1721–28), The Netherlands and Germany, specialising in sober bust-length portraits in oil. In 1737 he was admitted to the Confrerie Pictura in The Hague. It is unclear if he worked in pastel.

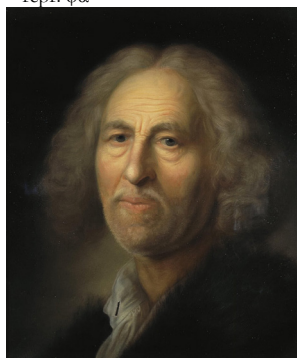
