### DENON, Dominique Vivant, baron

Givry 1747 – Paris 1825

A pupil of Vien, Denon was *agr  * and *re  * by the Acad  mie in 1787. He played a central role in arts administration under Napoleon, and was appointed directeur-g  n  ral du mus  e Napol  on. Only the pastel autoportrait is known, although there are some early medallion chalk drawings with pastel revealing the influence of Augustin de Saint-Aubin (probably also made in Chalon-sur-Sa  ne). His extensive collection was sold posthumously in 1826, and included a number of pastels and drawings with pastel.
