DERAMM, Christopher

Bragneres 1755 – Naples 1789

Norwegian miniaturist who also made some portraits in oil and pastel. The son of J. D. von Drama (also Dram, Deram etc.), he was trained by Hoyer at the academy in Copenhagen, winning the silver medal in 1780. He is recorded in Christiania (Oslo) as a miniaturist and pastelist in the early 1780s and in 1786 as a pupil in the Académie royale in Paris. Later he emigrated to Naples.
