DICKINSON, William

London 1746 – Paris 1823

Engraver; he received a medal from the Society of Arts in London in 1767. Among the numerous portraits he reproduced were pastels by Lauer and Russell (*qq.v.*). A pastel sold in 1929 as by “W. Dickenson” is presumably (supposed to be) by the same artist, by whom no other example is known.
