Artist, actor, singer and author. He was admitted to the Royal Academy Schools on 24.II.1770, and exhibited at the Society of Artists from 1769 and the Royal Academy from 1775. He is chiefly known for his numerous coloured prints (mainly caricatures and satires) which he sold from Spring Gardens, but he also produced large numbers of watercolours. Sée does not cite any specific work in pastel.
