DIJK, Johannes van

The Hague 1718–1798

Son of Hendrik van Dijk and Louise Blotelingh; married Anna Maria van Kervel in Scheveningen in 1747, and Anna Adrian Verschuring in 1784. He was a theological student in Leiden; preacher in Name 1749, Maastricht 1757; professor at the Illustre School te Maastricht from 1765. He was also an amateur artist of portraits and landscapes. There is a portrait by de Sompsois (*q.v.*).
