The author of Richard de Lédans's pastel was probably this member of the Académie de Saint-Luc, *reçu* 1771, rue de la Chaise, known for his religious paintings. He may have travelled to Italy. His widow was recorded in the rue des Vieilles-Tuileries in 1786.
