DUPONT, François-Léonard, dit Dupont-Watteau

Moorsele, Belgium 1756 – Lille 7.II.1821

Painter, miniaturist and pastellist, he was also an inventor. He moved to Lille where he was a pupil and medallist at the École de dessin, and he was *reçu* by the Académie there with a still life painting. Although he exhibited numerous pictures at the Lille salons, only one pastel is recorded. On 18.VI.1782, in Lille, he married Béatrice, daughter of his teacher Louis Watteau de Lille. Later he returned to his interests in mechanics.
