ENNIS, Jacob Dublin 1728 – Wicklow 1771

History and portrait painter; pupil of Robert West in Dublin, he also studied in Italy c.1754-56. Returning to Ireland, he succeeded West as professor of figure drawing in the Dublin Society school. Although no record survives of a pastel by him, the prevalence of the medium in the school suggests that he was probably an exponent.
