ESTERNO, Ange-Honoré- Philippe, comte d'

Paris 1770–1822

The younger comte d'Esterno, son of the third comte (*q.v.*), was made a baron de l'Empire in 1810; he left no children from his two marriages (the first to a sister of the duc de Brissac), nor is there any indication that he continued his amateur pursuit after the 1787 exhibition. He was described as an “homme d'esprit et de la sociabilité la plus douce”.
