Mlle Fauré or Faure cadette, pupil of the Académie; possibly related to Jean-François Fauré (*q.v.*). She is probably the Vitale Fauré who married her fellow student Pierre Laglaire in Toulouse, 30.I.1771; the contract was signed in the boutique de Me Sans, notaire, by the chevalier de Mondran. Before her marriage, she exhibited numerous exercises in drawing, pastel and unspecified media no doubt reflecting the pieces assigned to her for copying, which included religious works, flower pieces and an unspecified portrait by Perronneau.
