FAWORSKI, Józef

Warsaw ?1776 – p.1806

The son of a Warsaw portrait painter, Faworski was active between 1790 and 1805 in Poland and Berlin, painting portraits in oil and pastel of Polish nobles (those surviving in museums are in oil, and are very provincial in quality). He appears as a member of a Prussian masonic lodge 1803–06.
