**FAYE, Mme P.-A. de Villoutreys
de, née Julie-Jeanne-Nicole
Marcassus de Puymaurin**

Toulouse c.1750 – Faye, Flavignac 1816

The amateur exhibitor Mme de Faye can be identified as Julie Marcassus de Puymaurin, daughter of the baron de Puymaurin (1757–1841), art collector and patron of Rivalz, Despax etc. In 1771 she married Pierre-Auguste de Villoutreys de Faye (1736–1802), chevalier de Saint-Louis, lieutenant-colonel de cavalerie, brother of the vicaire-général de Toulouse. They had five children.
