Parma c.1470 – Milan 11.I.1546

Painter and sculptor. The technique of this early work with coloured chalks is unusual; the attribution (which cannot be confirmed in the absence of other pastels) is based on similar heads in his œuvre, such as in *The martyrdom of Saint Catherine* (Brera). Previous attributions included Bernardo Luini.
