FREDRIKS, Johannes Hendrik

Breda bpt 23.VIII.1751–27.III.1817

Also Jan Frederiks etc.; Dutch still life (numerous flower pieces appear at auction) and portrait painter, active in The Hague where he was a pupil in 1774, joined the Haagse Confreriekamer van Pictura in 1778 and remained until 1817. He visited Paris in 1780. In 1784 he married Joanna Catharina Tusel in Ginneken (now part of Breda). In 1799 he founded a drawing school with Charles van der Sluys, directeur of the Teken-Academie in Antwerp, Henri Louis de la Rivière and the drawing teacher from the military academy in Breda, Antoine Henri van Straatum.

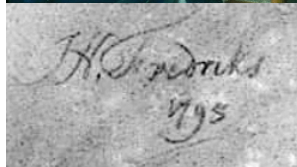
