FRONTIER, Jean-Charles

Paris 1701 – Lyon 1763

Pupil of Claude-Guy Hallé, he specialised in religious subjects. Prize-winner in 1728 at the Académie royale; *regu* in 1744, he moved to Lyon 12 years later.
