GUTBIER, Johann Christoph Philipp

Ohrdruf 1766–1840

No doubt related to Friedrich Augustin Philipp Gutbier, superintendent of Ohrdruf and archdeacon of St. Michaelis, Christoph Gutbier studied theology in Erfurt and Jena before training as a painter in Weimar; he was active also in Bamberg, Venice, Halberstadt. His main base seems to have been Gotha and the nearby town of Pferdingsleben, where he was an evangelical minister and schoolteacher. A son, Robert, was baptised there on 16.II.1808 to Johann Christop Philipp and Helena Sophia Gutbier. Among the subjects of his pastels were numerous members of the family of the artistic patron and publisher Bertuch. A group of four portraits, medium unknown, are listed as in the masonic Gothaer Loge of which he was no doubt a member (as was Herzog Ernst II. von Sachsen-Gotha); these may date from the nineteenth century.
