GABBIANI, Gaetano

Florence ?–c.1750

Nephew and pupil of Antonio Domenico Gabbiani. Despite a natural talent for painting which enabled him to make pastel portraits “con vivacità e con gusto”, he led a life of dissipation, spending his inheritance of more than 30,000 Florentine scudi in three years.
