GARDELLE, Jacques-André

Geneva 11.VIII.1725–p.1741

Miniaturist; according to Schidlof he also produced pastels. He was the son of Michel Gardelle (1685–1752) and Olympe Sarasin (1692–1750) (not of the painter Robert Gardelle (1682–1766)), nephew of Liotard's teacher Daniel Gardelle (1679–1753) and cousin of the miniaturist Théodore (in whose trial for murder in London Perronneau was a witness; a lengthy account appears in the *Annual register*, X, 1761, pp. 54–62). Robert and Daniel were the sons of Robert Gardelle, whose first wife Jeanne (–1678) was the daughter of the enamellist Joseph Petitot.
