Schweinfurt 1783 – Vienna 1809

Also Margarete, Margareta; daughter of Conrad Geiger (*q.v.*). She took lessons also from Christoph Fesel, Hofmaler in Würzburg. In 1806 she travelled to Bamberg and Munich, where she studied with Mannlich (*q.v.*). She then settled in Munich but her health deteriorated after the death of her father and she died aged 26. An accomplished self-portrait from 1804 is in the Mainfränkisches Museum.
