GERINI, marchese Andrea

Florence 1691–1766

Member of the important Florentine family (second son of Pietro Antonio Gerini, maestro di camera to gran principe Ferdinando); patron (in particular of Zocchi) and frequent lender to the exhibitions in Florence, and "un buon dilettante di pastello". According to Gabburri, he was "non solo amatore intendentissimo delle belle arti, ma che per suo spasso ha talora operato a pastelli con ottimo gusto." It is thought that a pastel shown in the 1715 exhibition lent by him was his own production.
