Braunschweig 1769–1836

Giem studied architecture and mathematics and was taught drawing by Schwarz and Weitsch at the Carolinum Braunschweig until 1791; in 1792 he was appointed to teach drawing at the Waisenhausschule in Braunschweig. The only known pastel looks very much like a copy of a Schröder, although it does not much resemble Schröder's portraits of the same sitter.
