GOUNON de Loubens, Jean-Mathieu

Toulouse 6.II.1769–27.I.1825

Pupil of Sabère, professeur at Toulouse, the exhibitor at the 1791 Salon was the son of the collector Joseph-François de Gounon, sgr de Loubens (1724–1802), secrétaire du roi (an office purchased by his father, a marchand-mercier), associé de l'Académie de Toulouse 1784, capitoul de Toulouse, and his wife, Antoinette de Ladoux. Joseph-François lent a pastel by Antoine Coypel to the Salon de Toulouse in 1769 and, in 1779, the posthumous portrait of his wife en Savoyarde by Valade. Jean-Mathieu, probably the brother of Jonquiérette de Gounon (*q.v.*), married Marie-Ombeline Marquier de Fajac and was the father of the painters Jules and (Ingres's pupil) Victor de Gounon-Loubens.
