HEUZINGER, Johann

Wolfenbüttel 1769 – Braunschweig 1846

The pastel given to Johann Heuzinger is presumably by the Johann Heusinger who worked as a miniaturist, draughtsman, porcelain painter and drawings teacher in Braunschweig, Wolfenbüttel, Berlin (where he was a member of the Künstler-Verein), Königsberg, Stargard Szczeciński and Szczecin, and specialised in portraits of members of the Hohenzollern family. An anonymous manuscript biography from 1819 has recently been published.
