HOG, James

London 28.I.1761–p.1795

A pupil of the engraver James Caldwell, he exhibited crayon portraits in 1773. James Hogg [sic] was admitted to the Royal Academy Schools on 6.X.1780 (aged “19 last Jany 28”). He later engraved work by Bartolozzi, John Raphael Smith, William Peters and others. He is not recorded after 1795. A James Hogg was buried at St Clement Danes 21.II.1804.
