HORSTINK, Warner

Haarlem 1756–1815

Pupil of the painter Cornelis van Noorde and of Wybrand Hendriks (*q.v.*; he made a portrait of Horstink), the artist, collector and curator of the Teylers Fundatie. Landscapes and numerous portraits in oil, watercolour and chalk are known; he also worked in miniature and made prints. He seems to have taught at the Haarlem Tekencollegie. Only a handful of pastels have been located.
