HALS, Frans

Antwerp c.1580 – Haarlem 1666

The virtuoso Dutch portraitist is not known to have used pastel. The Seymour-Conway sale item seems improbable, while the records of three pastels in the Vassal de Saint-Hubert sale by “M. Halz”, must be by Hall (*q.n.*); one (Lot 259) was in the 1777 salon. Scouler (*q.n.*) copied one of his portraits.
