London 1780 Master Charles Harris was an honorary exhibitor in 1780 but is not subsequently recorded. His submission was in chalk, but Graves inferred that he was a crayon painter. Alexander 2021 suggests he may have been the engraver apprenticed to Peter Mazell for 7 years from 12.III.1778 for a premium of 80 gns, but it is difficult to see how an apprentice could exhibit in this category.
