HAUCK, Johann Peter Friedrich

Homburg 20.XII.1723 – Wassersucht 18.V.1794
The artist J. P. F. Hauck known from oil portraits from the 1750s and thought to be Swiss (“der Baseler Maler”) was identified in a 2020 publication illustrating a series of pastels in the Städtischen Museen Heilbronn (gifted by Ilse Weddingen, a descendant of the Orth von Knapp family, in 1984). He was the son of another portrait painter, Johann Jacob Hauck or Haug, and thus the brother of Friedrich Ludwig and half-brother of August Christian (*qq.v.*). In the 1750s he painted a number of oil portraits in Basel, but by 1757, when he married Maria Magdalena Strenzin, he was settled in Heilbronn and naturalized there; he resided there until 1788. Among his patrons were princes of the Hohenlohe family, as well as the families Wacks and Orth, of whom he painted 19 members in pastel c.1779; not all are listed here.
