“Le sieur d'Hauteville, peintre en portrait, en pastel, desirant rester quelque temps en cette Ville offre ses services au public; il se flatte de contenter ceux qui coudront l'employer. Il est logé chez Mad. Pôté, Grande-Rue.” – *Affiches du Maine*, 4.IV.1785, p. 2. A carte de sûreté (AN F4787) was issued 17.XI.1793 for an “Adrien-Charles Gentilz dit d'Hauteville, peintre” at 57 rue Saint-Sauveur, 45 years old, native of Paris. He was married in Nantes, Saint-Nicolas, 3.II.1779 to a Madeleine-Françoise Brunet. He was again described as a “peintre” at the birth and death of their daughter in La Rochelle (29.VIII.1789) Rochefort (11.X.1789). He died 18.VIII.1803, then described as a “commis de banque”.
