HODGES, Charles Howard

London 23.VII.1764 – Amsterdam 24.VII.1837
The son of a miniaturist, Hodges entered the Royal Academy Schools on 8.III.1782 as an engraver, “aged 17 23d last July”, which appears to be the only evidence of his birth: no baptismal record has been located, and Feltz’s authority for a date of 23.VII.1764 in London, rather than the Portsmouth formerly reported, is a letter from the archives of the Royal Academy. Hodges was probably a student of John Raphael Smith (*q.v.*). He exhibited a portrait (medium unspecified, presumably in oil) at the Society of Artists in 1783 from 15 Goodge Street; the following year (St George, Hanover Square, 12.VIII.1784) he married Margaret Harmar and moved to Park Street. In 1784 he was awarded a silver medal by the Royal Academy. In 1788, with the dealer William Humphrey, he visited Amsterdam, where it had become fashionable to be portrayed by English artists. In 1789 he made a remarkable pastel copy of a painting by Rubens from the Düsseldorf collection formed by Johann Wilhelm von der Pfalz (now in Munich) which must have been made in connection with the programme of engraving the collection entrusted to Boydell and Green (Boydell published Hodges’s engraving in 1789). He was in Dublin c.1790–92, where he engraved portraits by Charles Gilbert Stuart; he emigrated permanently to The Netherlands in 1792, becoming a citizen of The Hague (and a member of the Pictura drawing academy) in 1793. He moved to Amsterdam in 1797 where, on 24.IV.1797, he was visited by the Irish rebel Wolfe Tone (*Diar*), who chatted with him for half an hour before choosing a “choice impression” of a mezzotint of Bonaparte to which Tone had subscribed (presumably that engraved by Hodges after J. T. Rusca). Hodges remained in Amsterdam until his death, although he seems to have kept a base in The Hague as well. The anglophilic of Amsterdam society was a major element of his success, and he became a member of the Felix Meritis society.

He worked in pastel, oil and mezzotint (his prints are signed with anagrams H. G. Does or H. S. Goed). The oil paintings all seem to belong to the period after 1800, but he continued to work in pastel throughout his career: an invoice of 26.VIII.1828 to a Heer Voombergh was for 65 guilders for a portrait in pastel, delivered with a gilt frame and glass. His work in pastel seems to have commenced under the influence of Tischbein (*q.v.*) in whose studio in the Keizersgracht Hodges worked on his first trip to Amsterdam in 1788. His copy of Tischbein’s painting of Johanna Sara Bicker demonstrates the English accent Hodges added to the German’s work. The velvety character of his pastels also reflects his training in mezzotint.

Unjustly neglected, Hodges’s pastels are highly finished, in natural poses. Often viewed di sotto in sù, his simple bust length figures are shown against plain, usually dark backgrounds. Hodges managed to combine the intensity of the best work of Hamilton with a sophisticated continental technique.

Baron van der Feltz’s monograph lists over 700 works, many in pastel, but mostly nineteenth century.
