HOLZER, Johann Evangelist

Burgusio 24.XII.1708 – Clemenswerth

21.VII.1740

Religious, mythological and portrait painter, frescoist and engraver, said also to have used pastel. Born in the South Tyrol, he was a pupil of Bergmüller at Augsburg. He was commissioned by Clemens August to paint frescoes at the Hofkirche in Clemenswerth but died before they were executed.
