HUDTWALCKER, Frau J. M., née Elisabeth Moller

Hamburg 6.VII.1752–22.XI.1804

“Die schöne Hamburgerin” of Mosnier’s 1798 painting (Hamburg, Kunsthalle) was the wife of Johann Michael Hudtwalcker (1747–1818), a senator of the city and a businessman. She was remarkably accomplished, fluent in English, French and Latin, as well as being an active amateur artist in oil, miniature and pastel. She is said to have been a pupil of Chodowiecki, J. H. W. Tischbein (*qq.v.*) and Schadow, and made portraits (probably in pastel) of her husband, parents-in-law and each of her five children.
