JOGUES, J. C.

fl. France 1760

The author of this apparent *hommage* to Oudry is unrecorded. A family of this name was based in Orléans (one of its members, Michelle-Narcisse Jogues de Martainville, Mme Chicoyneau, sold a house, 59, rue d'Auteuil, to Maurice-Quentin de La Tour in 1770; unable to complete the purchase, the house was acquired by Mme Helvétius). Jean-Louis-Laurent Jogues (Bourg 1818–) made a pastel copy of a Berjon still-life, signed and dated “L. Jogues 1841”.
