**JOUBERT, Jean**

c.1643 – Bourbon-l'Archambault, Allier, 1707  
Draughtsman and miniaturist; history, religious, animal and landscape pictures. He was the principal miniaturist for the house of Condé before becoming peintre du Cabinet du roi in 1685, where he made an exquisite series of paintings of flowers on vellum.
