Advertised his drawing school at the State Lottery house in the *Pennsylvania packet* of 8.1.1787, adding "Mr Jennings continues to Paint Likenesses in Miniature, at three guineas each: Head Size Portraits in Oil at four guineas, and in Crayon two guineas." Later (*General advertiser*, 11.VI.1792) he offered a subscription to a print of his painting of Liberty displaying the Arts and Sciences.
